Day 2

Thursday, June 16

Depart hotel for private, <u>Pre-Opening</u> Tour of **Edinburgh Castle.**

9:30 AM

We continue our morning with a walking tour of **Old Town Edinburgh** and the Royal Mile.

11:00 AM

MY LORD, MY LADY: AN INTRODUCTION TO THE SCOTTISH JUDICIAL SYSTEM

Guided visit and presentation at the **supreme civil court of Scotland, the Court of Session**. The presentation includes an introduction to the Scottish legal system, how the system operates under UK law, and a brief history of the various types of courts and judges. These differences are numerous and include a judge's courtroom attire and paraphernalia. American

lawyers will be able to make a meaningful cross-comparison to the relatively modern American legal system.

12:30 PM

Lunch at **Makars Gourmet Mash Bar** to experience one of Scotland's best haggis.

3:00 PM

THE SCOTTISH POLITICAL SYSTEM: A HYBRID OF UK AND EU LAWS

After lunch, we enjoy a guided tour and presentation at the **Scottish Parliament**. Here we learn about Scotland's unique political system, the balance between state autonomy and the centralized powers of the European Union, and the "Scottish Magna Carta." This gives way to Scotland's particular views on Brexit and its role in the overall process. We visit the **Debating Chamber** and a **Committee Meeting** to learn how legislative bodies pass laws, and how the courts may interpret them (schedules permitting).

Evening

Remainder of evening free. Dinner on your own. You'll find Edinburgh to be hilly but an extremely pedestrian friendly city with great shops and pubs.

Day 3

Friday, June 17

Morning

This morning, we depart for Scotland's second city and cultural hub – **Glasgow** (approx. 55 minutes).

Upon arrival to Glasgow, we enjoy Tea & Biscuits with members of **The Scottish Law Agents Society** (SLAS), originally incorporated by Royal Charter of Queen Victoria in 1883. SLAS is the oldest and the largest national voluntary association of solicitors in Scotland. Alternatively, we visit the **University of Glasgow School of Law** or a Local Legal Aid Society.

Walking tours, museum visits or other sightseeing will be made available for non-attorneys/guests who prefer skipping this morning's social.



Immerse yourself in a different side to Glasgow on this unique street art and modern culture tour. We will uncover some of the city's most beautiful pieces of art that are taking over walls by storm while learning about how the art scene in Glasgow has developed dramatically over the last decade. As part of our panoramic tour, we also dive into the local food and drink and the modern innovations of Glasgow.

A wide range of food tastings are included in the tour which will delight the foodies in all of us. Lunch included as part of the tour.

After the tour, we enjoy a front row and live experience of **Scottish music and dance** at a local Glasgow pub, before returning to Edinburgh.

10:00 AM Option A: Excursion to St. Andrews

Depart for the bucolic **St. Andrews** (Approx. 1 hour drive), a historic medieval town known for its many golf courses including the **Old Course**, considered the world's oldest. In St. Andrews we see the ruins of St Andrews Cathedral and the immaculate **University of St Andrews** founded in 1413. Free time will be given in town for independent lunch and shopping.

Time permitting, return to Edinburgh via the **Fife Coastal Path**. Along this stretch of picturesque coastline we see a series of charming, old-fashioned fishing villages.

3:15 PM Option B: Whisky Tour

Depart hotel for a guided tour and tasting at **Glenkinchie Distillery** (Approx. 35 mins drive).
