We will hear how the reign of the **Medici** family still affects legal and political systems to this day. The group will also hear about the artistic and literary byproducts of such a powerful reign, including *Dante Alighieri* and his **Divine Comedy**, **Botticelli**, **Masaccio**, **Giotto**, **Donatello**, and many others.

presentation introducing the group to the Italian judicial system. We then ponder the issue of separation of church and state. This is something Italians have to constantly reconcile, considering it is a deeply catholic country and the seat of the Pope. <u>Anticipated CLE Credit.</u>

We cross the river **Tevere** and have lunch by the **Barcaccia** and the **Spanish Steps**. Along the way, we will go on a walking tour of beautiful parts of the city.

After lunch, we spend the afternoon visiting the **Villa Borghese**. This villa is not only astoundingly beautiful in terms of its gardens and architecture, it also holds some of the most prolific Italian art of all time.




