

Day 1

Sunday April 14th

Morning

Day 2

Monday April 15th

Morning

Depart the hotel for our Vatican & Colosseum Tours.

Please remember there is a **dress code** at the Vatican that includes covering your shoulders and knees.

Vatican Tour including the Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica.



Afternoon

Lunch on-the-go and tour to see some of Rome's most famous landmarks.

Colosseum Tour. Visiting the Colosseum is an awe-inspiring experience transporting us back in time to the Ancient Roman Empire.



Day 3 Tuesday April 16

Morning

Depart for our meeting with the Rome Bar Association at the <u>Corte Suprema di Cassazione</u> (Italian Supreme Court). Libertà e Giustizia: The Italian Legal System at the Palazzo di Giustizia - the seat of the Supreme Court of Italy. Accompanied by representatives of the Rome Bar Association, we tour the Supreme Court and learn about the Italian judicial system.



Afternoon

Group lunch and lecture at La Zanzara Prati.

Family Affairs in Italy: Navigating Family Law and the Church's Influence on Women's Rights. Discussion with Danielle Miklos, a New York litigator living and working in Italy who will discuss how the Church impacts women in divorce proceedings and other Constitutional matters.

After lunch, group **walking tour** to see some of Rome's most famous landmarks including the **Trevi Fountain** and the **Pantheon**.

Alternatively, Jewish Ghetto tour through the historic Jewish Quarter of Rome, providing insights into the history, culture and heritage of the Jewish community in Rome.

Before returning to the hotel, optional **Gelato tasting** at a local favorite *Gelateria*.

Remainder of the afternoon/evening is free. Dinner on your own.

Day 4 Wednesday April 17th

Hotel check out and depart for Florence.

On arrival in Florence, hotel check in.

Afternoon

Depart the hotel for our **Florence Walking Tour & orientation**. We see the *Duomo di Firenze*, a masterpiece of architecture designed by Florentine Renaissance architect **Filippo Brunelleschi**.

Here the group will learn about the history of Florence as an economic and legal powerhouse spanning hundreds of years through both the medieval and renaissance periods. We will hear how the reign of the **Medici family** still affects legal and political systems to this day.

Guided visit to *Galleria dell'Accademia* to see highlights of the Collection including **David**, a masterpiece by **Michelangelo**.



Florence Welcome Dinner at **FrancescoVini**, a traditional Florentine restaurant known for its wine cellar located in the ruins of a Roman amphitheater below the restaurant. Some consider this the finest steak in the city and is served rare.

At dinner we are joined by Florence local **Elia Nichols**, Public Speaking & Communication Coach and Tedx Speaker Coach, for an engaging presentation on "**Public Speaking for Lawyers**."

Optional after-dinner walking orientation of the nearby nightlife.

Day 5 Thursday April 18th

Morning

Fashion and Intellectual Property Law in the EU

This meeting will take place at the Spheriens Avvocati law firm, where we will receive an introduction to Fashion and Intellectual Property in the European Union, focusing on numerous interesting cases handled by the firm. Our speakers will be partners and associates of the firm.

After our morning meeting, we return to the city center for Group lunch with Special Guests.

Higher Education Law: THE GDPR and Educating in Paradise

We hear from **Gian Franco Borio**, a lawyer specialized in all legal aspects of higher education and advanced international studies. We learn about various topics, including the rise of study abroad programs in Italy, property law, immigration issues, taxation, and conflicts with U.S. law.

Afternoon

Visit to *Galleria degli Uffizi*, one of the oldest museums in the whole of Europe that was a gift to the State from the Medici family. The collection is mainly of the Renaissance period and includes works by the great Italian Masters including **Botticelli**, Giotto, Cimabue, **Michelangelo**, **Leonardo da Vinci** and **Raffaello**. Its large collection has works from all centuries but a large part dates back to the periods between the 12th and 17th centuries.



OR Free time for shopping and leisure.

Dinner and evening entertainment on your own.

Day 6 Friday April 19th

Morning

This morning we depart for the **Chianti Wine Region** by private coach for a **day of wine tasting**.

Late Lunch & Lecture at a local winery.



Denied Justice and the Rule of Blood: The History of Italian Citizenship

Discussion with Florence attorney **Michele Capecchi**. *Jus Sanguinis* ("the right of blood" in Latin) has given millions across the globe the opportunity to claim Italian citizenship. However, issues related to Italian bureaucracy and outdated gender laws continue to make this process difficult. Mr. Cappecchi will be discussing these difficulties, specifically the "1948 exception" which allows many individuals to claim citizenship *only from their paternal line*.

Afternoon

Return to the hotel by private Coach.

Dinner on your own. Optional evening entertainment, cultural calendars pending.











Day 7 Saturday April 20th

For those continuing towards Southern Italy, Hotel Checkout and depart for **Sorrento**.

Our first stop is in **Naples**. Time permitting, brief orientation walk before lunch.

For today's lunch, we enjoy authentic **TSG Certified Pizza** *Napoletana* at <u>Palazzo Petrucci Pizza</u>. Weather permitting, we dine on the rooftop overlooking the busy plaza below.

La Camorra and Italian Criminal Law: The History of the Mafia Napoletana: Afternoon discussion with Alessandro Milone, a post-doctoral research fellow at the University of Federico II in Naples. He will focus on prominent individuals in the Italian mafia, and the anti-mafia legislative response in Italy, including the recent "emergency legislation."

Afternoon

Express Pompeii Tour with Archeologist and local site specialist. From Pompeii, we continue towards **Sorrento**.



Arrive to our hotel in Sorrento overlooking the **Tyrrhenian Sea** followed by a welcome Reception with hors d'oeuvres on the Hotel Terrace.

Day 8

Sunday April 21st

Day excursion of the **Amalfi coast**. Italy's famed Amalfi Coast boasts a classic Mediterranean landscape, blending breathtaking terrain and dramatic coastline with terraced vineyards, orchards, and pastures—often with mesmerizing views of the waters below.

Free time today will be allocated for boutique shopping and play.

Afternoon

Lunch in Positano.

After lunch, we enjoy an authentic *Limoncello and Crema di Limone* tasting and experience at **Antichi Sapori d'Amalfi**, a family owned laboratory and factory spanning generations. Here, we will do a "degustazione" of different types of Limoncello, Crema di Limone, and other liquors typical of the Amalfi Coast.

We continue touring this beautiful region of Italy before returning to Sorrento.

Evening

Hotel Shuttle or taxi service is available to go to the town center or you may choose to eat at the hotel.



Monday April 22nd

After breakfast we depart for the **island of Capri**. Our day trip to Capri is the perfect way to experience the beauty and charm of this stunning island off the coast. You'll start your day with a relaxing boat ride from the Port of Sorrento, taking in the breathtaking views of the Mediterranean Sea and the towering cliffs of Capri.

Once you arrive on the island, you'll have free time to explore on your own some of its most iconic sights or just kick back and relax.

Unwind with a leisurely lunch on your own at one of the island's many restaurants, savoring fresh seafood and local specialties.
